



New Hampshire Tech Alliance names Hypertherm's Powermax SYNC "Product of the Year" finalist

HANOVER, N.H.—Oct. 14, 2021—Hypertherm, a U.S. based manufacturer of industrial cutting systems and software, today announced that its Powermax SYNC™ series—three new plasma systems with built-in intelligence and a revolutionary single-piece cartridge consumable—is a New Hampshire Tech Alliance Product of the Year finalist.

Additionally, controls right on the torch allows operators to save time by adjusting the amperage and changing out the cartridge without returning to the power supply. As you use your Powermax SYNC system, it is continuously recording performance data such as the number of starts and arc-on time. Having this information can help operators and their managers more quickly identify issues and troubleshoot problems.
